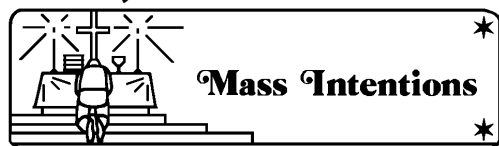

CATECHESIS OF THE GOOD SHEPHERD

Our parishes will begin a Catechesis of the Good Shepherd Atrium (classroom) in September 2010 at St. Margaret Mary Church. Initially this will be Level I-for ages 3-6-but eventually we hope to be able to offer Levels II (ages 6-9) and III (ages 9-12). Catechesis of the Good Shepherd is a Montessori method of religious education. HOST FAMILIES NEEDED FOR SPANISH TEENS IN JULY

Expand your family's horizons this summer by welcoming a student from Spain into your home through the STEP-to -U.S.A. program. The boys and girls, who range in age from 14 to 18, will arrive on June 29 and spend four weeks in New Hampshire/Vermont., departing on July 26. The students are all from the Basque region of Spain and must have excellent grades, attendance and behavior in school and also pass an English conversational interview to be accepted into the program. Most are practicing Catholics. Host families are asked to provide a warm and safe home environment for the student, as well as meals and transportation to a meeting spot on the days there are field trips (to New York, Boston, and Six Flags, and host siblings are invited to come along). It's fine for a student to share a room with a host sibling. The students have their own spending money and phone cards.
